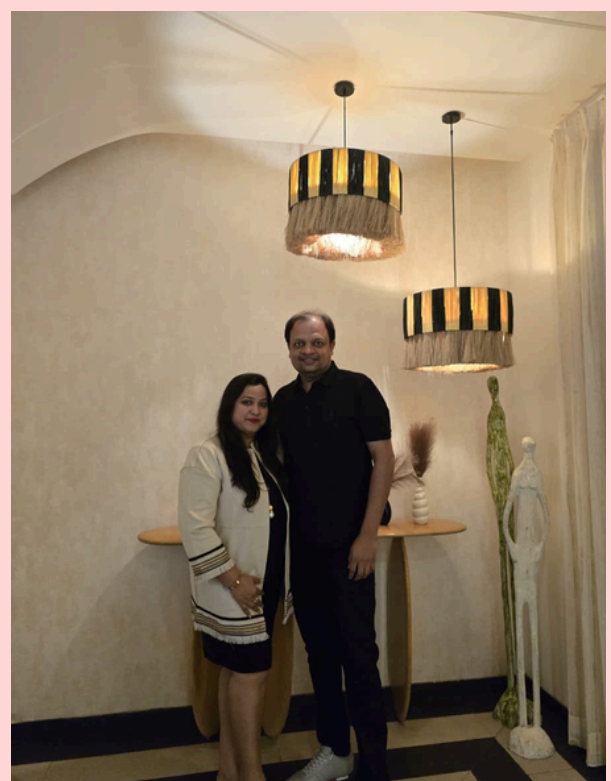

REIMAGINING BUSINESS WITH AI: A PRACTICAL GUIDE INSPIRED BY RTN BIJAL SANGHAVI

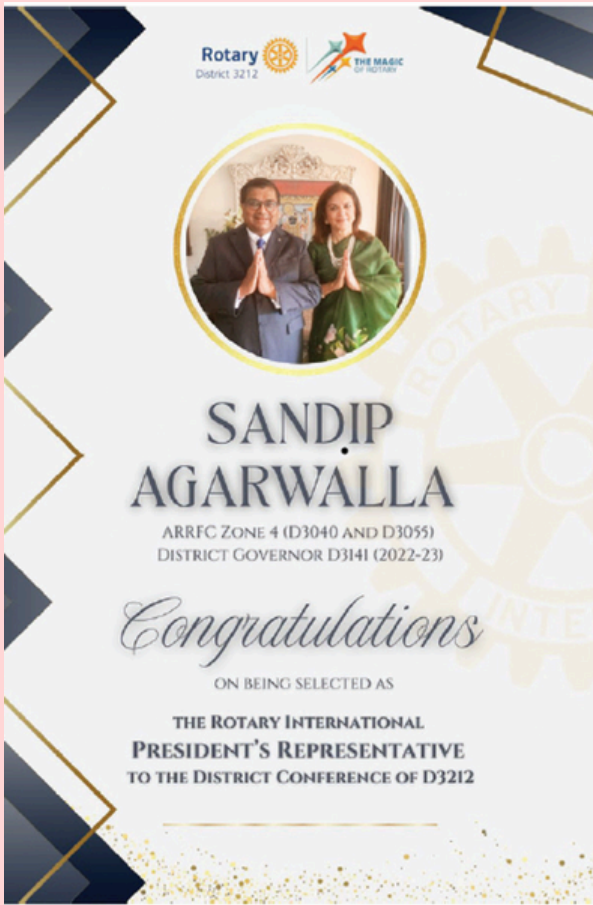
